

Permanent Cosmetics – Lips Aftercare

WOW! You look great. Thank you for trusting us with your beautiful lips!

Here are the things you need to do, and not do.

TO DO:

PLEASE keep any judgments of your completed tattoo until 3 weeks after your last tattoo appointment! Your lips need to heal, and they will look beautiful in no time! Your lips will soften and the “harsh” looking color will start to fade within 3-7 days. Please don’t be alarmed if your lips crack, or have some discharge. These are all totally normal healing signs, and its best not to get upset if you’re feeling uneasy. Give me a call and I would be happy to go over any of your concerns.

Right after you leave, please keep your luscious lips on ice for 10-15 mins once every hour, for the 1st 4-8 hours (the longer you ice is for your comfort). After the 1st 24 hours, icing is purely for your comfort.

It’s very important to keep the areas clean and moist!

If your lips are feeling too dry or irritated, give those ladies some love and get your lips moist, but be careful not to use petroleum-based products! **Check out our post care lip products, sold in our spa! You can also use Vitamin E and A&D ointment. Use VERY liberally being careful not to pull or stretch your lips.

When you need to brush your teeth, before bedtime, showers, eating etc.. Put some ointment on your lips (be very liberal) that will help them stay hydrated and not crack or stretch. Plus it keeps off any un-wanted products. MUAH!!!

Please, Do Not:

Pick or scratch at the area. Some scabbing is 100% normal and its best to let the skin scab and fall off. Anything you tear off will most likely take the pigment with it. Leave your beautiful self alone!!

Be careful with toothpaste and mouthwash, as these products are very stringent and can remove color. As stated above, make sure to liberally use ointment on them before doing any hygiene routines.

We ask that you please keep any makeup off of the tattooed area for at least 7 days.

You need to be super gentle with your freshly tattooed skin, so applying any makeup that doesn't come off easily is probably not the best idea. Please, please, Don't rub or stretch the tattooed area, and keep yourself looking amazing!!!

Note*

- Swelling, oozing, and some redness are normal the next day after the procedure for some clients. You're welcome to use Benadryl (over the counter). Also trying to keep your face vertical can be helpful.
- Shedding of the tattoo color and some skin around your lips (outer epidermal skin) is normal during the first 3-4 days following treatment.
- At the end of three weeks, your procedure should be healed. Please contact me if you feel that the treatment area needs to be touched up. If this touch up is needed, we have got your back (really your lips, but you know what I mean...) . Please try to not wait any longer than 3-6 weeks after the 1st procedure, to have this done, as there could be an additional charge if things end up needing more than the standard time for a touch up. Should I require a third or any additional touch-ups, please understand that there will be an additional charge for that service.. but that almost never happens, so lets hope for the best!
- Should you suspect an infection in or around the procedure area, please contact me or your health care provider immediately!
